Items with built-in rechargeable batteries are often made of plastic on the outside, but should never be disposed of as plastic waste due to the risk of ignition or explosion!





Remove the battery Main unit 1 Non-burnable Garbage

Take out

Battery Separate as below

Take out the main unit as "Non-burnable Garbage", and take the battery pack to the recycling partner stores.





Items with non-removable battery is Hazardous Garbage

Dispose of at a collection point as below

Put them in a designated plastic bag
