## **Administrative Radio Broadcast**

Matsudo City uses the "Administrative Radio Broadcast" as one means of spreading important information concerning disasters, etc.

Information concerning disasters, such as evacuation notices and evacuation site openings, etc. can be obtained.

※ When there are no emergencies, the system provides regular broadcasts, such as the going-home jingle every evening, as well as information about wandering elderly persons, etc.

## **Disaster Information Automated Hotline**

Depending on the surrounding environment and whether you are inside the house, etc., it may be difficult to hear the content of the broadcast. In those cases, you may call a dedicated toll-free number to hear the broadcast.

Please call the number below if you didn't hear the broadcast well, or would like to check it again. We recommend that you register the number on your smartphone.



## Matsudo Safety Mail Service

This is a service that automatically delivers information on disasters, suspicious persons, crimes, etc. to your mobile phone by email upon request.

Please register so that you can receive emails with emergency information, such as, evacuation information, and information on evacuation area openings.

## **Disaster Prevention Information Phone / Fax Service**

This service delivers evacuation information and information on the opening of evacuation shelters to fixed-line phones, cell phones (smartphones and feature phones), and faxes in the event of a disaster.

To apply for this service, ① pick up an application form at the Crisis Management Division, branch offices, civic centers, or other public facilities, ②download the form from the city's official website, fill in the necessary information, and bring, mail, or fax it to the Crisis Management Division, or ③apply through Matsudo City's online application system.

## **Other Information Sharing Methods in Matsudo**

#### Emergency Alert Mail (Area Mail) Service

This is a service that sends out emails to the mobile phones of people in areas at-risk of a disaster. As long as you are in the area, you will be able to receive these emails for free and no registration is required.

(XYou may not be able to receive mails due to signal strength, your mobile phone model, its settings, etc.)


## **Disaster Emergency Message Dial**

(Provided by NTT)

In the event of a major disaster in Japan, such as an earthquake of intensity of 6 or higher on the Japanese seismic intensity scale, a voice message can be recorded and played back.

## [ Recording message]


Call **171**, then press **1** 



Example of a message: "This is (your name). All members of my family are safe. We are at (name of the evacuation site, etc.)."

(Keep your message shorter than 30 seconds.)
