Housing Support Subsidy for Newlyweds



Matsudo City provides subsidies to newly married households starting a new life for their “housing purchase costs,” “housing rent,” “moving costs,” and/or “renovation costs” within the budget limit.

Major subsidized expenses

Housing Acquisition Expenses

The cost of purchasing a building for a house upon marriage

- Construction and/or purchase of a new house
- Purchase of a used house

Housing Rental Expenses

Expenses for housing rented upon marriage

- Rent
- Common service fee
- Deposit
- Key money
- Agency fee

Moving Expenses

Expenses paid to a moving company for moving upon marriage

(This does not apply if you moved yourselves, or asked a friend to help you)

Renovation Costs

Expenses for renovation of a house upon marriage, including repairs, expansion, reconstruction, and renewal of facilities to maintain or improve the function of the house.

Application Period

June 1, 2022 – March 31, 2023 (By mail)

Applications will close once the allocated budget is depleted, so please apply as early as possible.

Application Process

* This is just one example. Please also check our website for details.



- STEP1** Couples married between January 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023 are eligible.
- STEP2** Please move to Matsudo City (relocation within Matsudo City is also OK).
- STEP3** Expenses incurred on and after January 1, 2022 are eligible for subsidy.
- STEP4** Apply for the subsidy (application is closed when the budget limit is reached).
- STEP5** After reviewing your application, the city will deposit the subsidy into your designated account in about one month.

Requirements (All of the following requirements must be met in order to use this subsidy program.)

Requirements	
<input type="checkbox"/>	The applicants are a married couple whose marriage registration was submitted and accepted between January 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023 .
<input type="checkbox"/>	The couple's total income from January 1 to December 31, 2021 was less than 4 million yen. * If the applicant has left his/her job and is unemployed at the time of their application, his/her part of income will be calculated as no income. * If the applicant is currently repaying scholarship loans, the amount of annual repayment will be deducted from the couple's household income during calculations.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Both spouses are 42 years old or below as of the date of their marriage.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The address of the newlyweds at the time of their application is the residence considered in the application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The applicants have not received a similar type of subsidy from the national or local government under other laws or regulations.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The applicants must be willing to live in Matsudo City for at least two years from the date the subsidy is provided.
<input type="checkbox"/>	None of the applicants are a member of organized crime groups, as defined in Article 2, Item 6 of the "Act on Prevention of Unjust Acts by Organized Crime Group Members".

Required Documents
