

Do You Know this System ?

Reduction of National Health Insurance Premium for Involuntarily Unemployed Persons because of Restructuring

Those who are involuntarily unemployed persons as a result of restructuring may possibly receive assistance in payment of National Health Insurance premium, the amount of which is calculated based on 30/100 of their salary income of previous year, subject to their necessary application. This way of calculation based on 30/100 of their salary income of previous year may possibly be applied for assessment of the income under the reimbursement system for high-cost medical care too.
